Materials - You are required to bring your notebook with blank paper, Agenda book, calculator, & pencil to class each day. Java & Data Structures students must bring their textbook to class each day as well. All students should bring their own USB flash drive to class in order to transfer files between home and school.

Extra Help - If you have questions during class, ask them at an appropriate time. You are expected to see me after class and/or after school if you miss class, fall behind, or need extra help.

Homework Assignments - Homework assignments will be checked and/or corrected occasionally at the very beginning of class. Depending on the assignment, you may be able to turn it in late the very next day for a maximum grade of 50%. Homework turned in more than one day late is not worth any credit but will still be collected and checked.

Website - Our class website at www.minich.com/education/wyo contains lecture notes, practice tests, homework assignments, and other resources.

Computer Use – Many computer programming projects will be assigned. You will be required to work on some assignments outside of class and to transfer the files to and from our computer lab on a USB flash drive. Failure to turn in a single project could cause you to earn a very low grade or even fail a report period.

Software - The programming software is free and you are expected to download and install it on your home computer. Contact me ASAP if you do not have a home computer where you can install the software.

Grades - Grades will be posted online at eschoolbook.wyoarea.org. It is your responsibility to regularly check your grade and to see me if you have questions or concerns. I do not give extra credit, especially at the end of a report period.

Missed Work/Absence - It is your responsibility to promptly make up work missed due to absences. Most assignments are posted on the class website but you are also responsible for contacting a classmate or me to learn what you missed. If you miss a test, it is your responsibility to see me immediately, upon your return, in order to schedule the make-up.

Academic Honesty - Cheating is a serious offense and will be dealt with strongly in this class. Examples of cheating include copying homework, sharing computer files, communicating answers via email, texting, or instant messaging, logging into another person's network account, and copying part or all of an assignment from the Internet. All quotes and references in written assignments and computer programs must be properly cited. Homework and programming assignments are meant to be completed individually and not to be copied from another student or resource. I will make it very clear when I assign group work.

Comparing your answers with another student even if you don't change your answers is cheating! I give zeros to both students in that situation.
