

Write statements that perform the following tasks. See the lecture notes for sample exercises of this type.

1. Use the + concatenation operator to concatenate what is stored in `lblName` to the end of the phrase "My name is " and display the whole thing in a message box.

2. Use the + concatenation operator to concatenate the string "Mr. " to the front of what is found in a textbox named `txtName` and display the whole thing in `lblOutput`.

3. Write a line of code that uses the + concatenation operator to concatenate the strings "Wyo" to "missing" and places the whole thing in a message box.

4. Write a line of code that uses the + concatenation operator to concatenate the following three items in this exact order: "19610", a hyphen symbol (-), and what is found in `lblZipLastFour` and then places the whole thing in a label named `lblZipCode`.
